The new flooring is in addition to other recent improvements such as a food grade railcar dock and two truck docks. Collectively, these enhancements support the safe handling and storage of weather-sensitive products such as particleboard, OSB, plywood and southern yellow pine lumber. The Odon Transload Facility boasts 9,600 sq ft of warehouse capacity and offers transloading services Monday through Friday.
